

"In the enforcement of the provisions of Section II of the Act of November 3, 1893, relating to the application for admission of alleged returning Chinese merchants, it will not be enough to have witnesses testify that an applicant for at least one year before his departure from the United States was not engaged in the performance of any manual labor except such as was necessary in the conduct of his business as such merchant, but the testimony should show specifically the kind of work the Chinaman has done during the entire year, and, after detailing the character of such work, should say that he has not performed any other labor than that specifically set forth." (UNITED STATES TREASURY DECISION NO. 81,039.)

- 14 Do you know whether or not during the period referred to the applicant worked as a laundryman, peddler, servant, farmer, ranch hand, cook, fisherman, miner or at any other labor? No.
- 15 Can you state that you know he performed no other labor during that period thru that stated in Question 13? Yes.
- 16 Upon what do you base your knowledge of the above? Business dealing.
- 17 How frequently did you visit the store of applicant during the year prior to date? About 6 times a year.
- 18 During the said period did you always find the applicant engaged in said store? Yes.
- 19 Can you name any other partners in this firm? Leutkow.
- 20 If not, why not?
